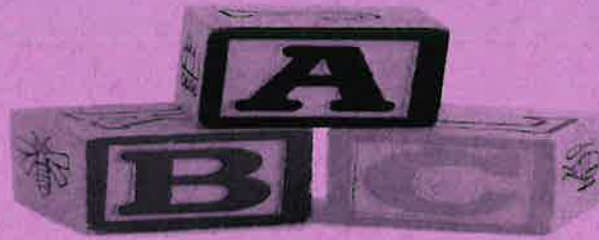


Ways to Practice Sounds and Letters at Home



- Read, read, read
- Use alphabet books to reinforce letters and sounds
- write letters on cards or use flash cards. Hold up a card and have your student say the letter and sound
- Matching sounds to letters - You say a sounds and student picks out corresponding card (do not put out more than 6 cards at a time)
- Make a letter sound and ask your student to write the matching letter (students love using whiteboards!)
- Hide and go Seek - hide plastic letters or letters on Post it notes around the room Have student find letters, and then tell you the sound and name of the letter.
- Concentration- use 2 sets of flash cards, so you can play concentration and matching. You could also use one set uppercase and one set lowercase
- Don't Fall in the Swamp - lay letters out on floor or path. Have your child step on the letters, they say the letter name and sound. If
